COURSE DESCRIPTION AND OBJECTIVES	Through creative and analytical exercises, students will study the chromatic materials of tonal music, with an emphasis upon late 18 th - and 19 th –century compositions. The vocabulary will include: modulation, mode mixture, Neapolitan and augmented-sixth chords, altered dominants, enharmonic relationships, and chromatic and double-chromatic median relationships. Students will study how large-scale forms (sonata, rondo) are defined and given their unique character by the use of these materials and by sophisticated developmental procedures.
