Major Degree Requirements:

- BA (Music) students who are not doing a Sonic Arts Concentration should take MUSI 311/313 as their 300+ Foundation area option courses.
- Students may take a maximum of **60 credits** in the Field of Music.
- It is recommended that students choose [Music 451](#) or [453](#) in partial fulfillment of the Upper-Level Courses requirement.
- Students are urged to plan ahead in their selection of these courses to ensure that they meet prerequisites.
- Students with an interest in pursuing a Sonic Arts Concentration should select [Music 351](#) and [355](#) to meet the Foundation Course requirement of 6 units (1.0 full-course equivalent) at the 300 level in Composition, Sonic Arts or Theory.
- All students must meet theory entrance requirements (via RCM Level 8- all instruments, Level 10 Voice; or MUSI 209; or by Theory Diagnostic Exam)

Other Degree Requirements:

- All students must complete a total of **120 credits** to be eligible to graduate.
- All students must complete **72 credits** of Open Options, they may be selected from any program, including Music courses not required for completion of the program.
- Students may take a maximum of **48 units** at the 200-level.
