BFA degree requirements:

- Students must complete **60 units** in their major field of Drama.
- Drama 203 and 205 may only be counted towards open options
- Students wishing to pursue graduate school are encouraged to take courses in one modern language other than English

Other Degree Requirements:

- All students must complete a total of **150 units** to be eligible to graduate.
- All students must complete a total of **60 units** in Werklund School of Education
- All students must complete **30 units** of Open Options, they may be selected from any program, including Drama courses not required for completion of the program. 3 units should be taken in English and 12 options in Fine Arts, which may be selected from Art (ART), Art History (ARHI), Dance (DNCE), Drama (DRAM), Film (FILM), Fine Arts (FINA), Music (MUSI), Music Education (MUED), Music Performance (MUPF), and School of Creative and Performing Arts (SCPA).
- Students must maintain a minimum GPA of 2.50 in their Arts components to enter years 3 and 5 of the Education Program
- To enter the first year in Education students must have completed EDUC 201.
- It is strongly recommended that students in the concurrent elementary route take Science 331 (no prerequisites).
- The concurrent program must end on an Education year.
